Attach the metal plate to the upright as shown using the provided hardware.







## Step 02


ATTACH BASE PLATE TO SUPPORT.

Attach the base plate to the upright as shown using the provided hardware.

## Additional Information

### CARE:

Keep your table out of direct sunlight to reduce discoloration over time. High-temperature items, including hot coffee mugs and bowls, may create heat stains and mar your table. Use a hot pad to protect the surface. Wipe up spills immediately. Clean with a slightly damp, soft cloth. Do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

### WOOD:

To remove dirt and fingerprints, use a quality cleaner formulated for wood furniture. Wipe completely dry with a soft cloth in the direction of the wood grain.

### MARBLE:

Natural stone top will have variances in appearance and each piece is unique. Wash with a mixture of liquid dish soap and warm water and then dry with a paper towel or soft dish towel. To help avoid stains, this table comes pre-sealed. We recommend re-sealing the honed marble, every year or two to keep the surface protected. Please contact your local hardware store for professional guidance.

### LAMINATE:

Wash with a mixture of liquid dish soap and warm water. Rinse with cold water and then dry with a paper towel or soft dish towel. Always rinse your laminate after cleaning – if left unrinsed, cleaning solution or soap will remain on the surface and may eventually cause marring.
