





Parts & Hardware



*For large and corner sofas only

Step 01 ATTACH THE LEGS Attach legs using the provided hardware as shown.*




*For large and corner sofas, don't forget to install the center foot.




ATTACH MALE SECTIONAL CONNECTOR.

This hardware allows proper alignment of the sectional sofas and lolds them in place during use.

Underside of Chaise











ATTACH FEMALE SECTIONAL CONNECTOR

This hardware allows proper alignment of the sectional sofas and holds them in place during use.

Underside of One Arm Sofa








Step 04

CONNECT SECTIONAL SOFAS.

With back sides aligned, carefully slide sectional sofas together. Make sure sectional connector latches for a secure placement.



Additional Information

CLEAN

Vacuum your upholstery regularly.

SPILLS

Act quickly with spills. Absorb the spill with a clean white cloth or paper towel. Never rub the surface. Do not use water or other liquids to clean, as they may stain the fabric. Consult a commercial cleaning specialist for removal of stubborn stains.

AVOID

Keep upholstery & felt furniture out of direct sunlight and away from heat sources; excessive exposure to sunlight may fade the color of the upholstery. Avoid placing heavy or sharp objects on the furniture surface for long periods of time; this can cause permanent indentations in the fabric. For snags in the fabric, tuck loose threads into fabric or carefully push to reverse side. Never pull out or cut off loose threads.
